#### HANDY HOOKUP INSTRUCTIONS:

Thank you for purchasing the **Handy Hookup Chain Securing System.** We believe this product offers tremendous benefits in simplifying the attaching and detaching of trailer safety chains with the bed loops. It is our hope that this tool design will serve you well and save much effort and injuries from climbing in and out of the bed of your truck to make these necessary attachments and disconnects. We have inserted this simple instructions and usage sheet for your convenience. Please use this tool only for its intended usage to avoid damage to the tool and injury to your person. ### A. Loop Bridge Installation

- 1. Simply lift the bed loop with one hand and slide in the Loop Bridge from the side.
- 2. There is a right loop bridge and a left loop bridge.
- 3. Make sure the saw tooth edge is at the inside rear of the loop.
- 4. Insert the bridge from outside in ( which keeps the bridge away from the hitch components.
- 5. There are two notches on the bridge for height adjustment of the loop, when using larger hooks.
  - a. The loop bridge may remain in the bed loop until which time you would like to remove it for hauling or just desired removal.
  - b. Attaching a smaller hook as shown in the website videos, it is possible to insert the safety chain hook and the breakaway cable in the same loop.
  - c. Most states require safety chains.
  - Federal and state laws require breakaway kits on trailers with a gross weight of 3000 pounds or more.
  - e. It is best to check with state and federal laws to be in compliance with their standards.

# B. Using the Handy Hookup Tool

- 1. It is most helpful to turn the hook with the spring loaded side away from you.
- 2. Coming from the bottom end of the hook, allow the spine of the hook to rest in the channel of the Hookup tool, with the ¼ inch round pin on the opposite side of the hook.
- 3. Squeezing the trigger handle firmly but gently, allow the pin of the tool to squeeze open the spring latch of the hook.
- 4. Make sure you have a secure grip on the hook with all components in the proper position before lifting and making the connection.
- 5. With just a limited amount of practice, this process gets easier and more enjoyable to perform.
- 6. Simply insert the hook into the Bed Loop and release the trigger handle.

## C. Detaching the Hooks

- 1. With the same process as the hooking up of the chain hooks, simply reverse the process.
  - a. Grab the hook with the spine of the hook in the channel of the tool and the ¼ round pin on the spring latch side.
  - b. Make sure the tool is properly positioned, then squeeze the trigger handle allowing the pin of the tool to suppress the spring latch.
  - c. Slide the hook out of the bed loop and you are done.

### D. Intended Usage

- 1. Use this tool for intended use only, to prevent damage to tool and injury to humans.
- 2. Store in a dust free area if possible.
